Because of the unfavorable travel conditions, they would go three months without the pastor's presence.

He remembered the dedication of the brothers and sisters who prepared the table with the elements for Communion, not knowing if they would be able to celebrate the sacrament, since in their tradition a pastor must serve Communion.

Just as his church prepared itself for that momentous celebration of the Christian faith, Advent reminds me of our waiting for the Son of God.

Advent is a time to prepare the way of the Lord. The crooked roads shall become straight and our rough ways smooth.

A child will be born! Something eternally significant will come to all the people and all will know the way to abundant life,

We need to open ourselves once again to welcome Jesus as our Savior and liberator.
