Passover Seder 2026

A Passover Seder will be held on ***Maundy Thursday, April 2*** hosted by First Presbyterian Church and First United Methodist Church. The service will be held in the fellowship hall of First Presbyterian Church, 302 N. McLeod in Cuero and will be led by Rev. Lindsey Smith and Rev. Dr. Kevin Boyd. The Passover meal commemorates Israel's deliverance from enslavement to Pharaoh and the blood of the lamb that caused death to pass over the Israelites. Jesus saw Passover as a pivotal event, eagerly desiring to share the meal with His disciples before His suffering, declaring its fulfillment in the Kingdom of God, and transforming the traditional meal into the Lord's Supper (Communion) by instituting the bread and wine as symbols of his body and blood, pointing to his ultimate sacrifice as the true Passover Lamb. When Christians celebrate the Seder, we honor our spiritual heritage and learn the origins of one of our most central Christian sacraments.

There is lots of food preparation to be done and all are invited to help prepare the traditional recipes. A suggested donation of \$8.00 per plate will help defray the cost of the meal, but all are most welcome. In order to facilitate the preparations, reservations are requested.
